1: Formatting

2: Deciding on the best font

3: Layer Styles

1: Locate adobe editor on your computer

2: Click on new page

3: write a line of text {anything will do}

4: Highlight "what a cool header" and click on font. Change the font to whatever you like.

5: next locate "layers" in the photoshop menu bar and again choose one that you like.

6: Lastly, simply resize to whatever you want.

How easy was that? there is obviously a lot more that can be done to further enhance your work like adding more layers to your text giving even more different combinations.

Given a bit of time and practice you will be able to create hundreds of different combinations and make your work something to be proud of.
