For the majority of printers, a specific printer cartridge is needed for it to operate. In recent years some manufacturers have made available a program to recycle the printer cartridges used in their printers. This many times furnishes the consumer with a savings in return for bringing in an empty cartridge for a rebate. There are also some printers that require more than one type of cartridge depending on the kind of copies produced. Typically, color printers need at a minimum two cartridges to create color copies. Other types of printers need four cartridges for color printing jobs.
